Chandrababu allocates portfolios to Ministers

Hyderabad: Andhra Pradesh Deputy Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu will be the Home Minister while another Deputy Chief Minister, K. Krishna Murthy, will look after revenue, stamps and registration.

Three days after the State cabinet was sworn in, Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu on Wednesday distributed portfolios among the Ministers. Naidu will hold general administration, law and justice, energy, infrastructure, investment, industries, commerce, cinematography, tourism and other portfolios not allocated to ministers.

Naidu and 19 Ministers had taken oath on Sunday at a gala ceremony near Guntur.

Senior Telugu Desam Party (TDP) leader Y Ramakrishnodu is the Finance Minister. He will also hold the

portfolios of planning, commercial taxes and legislative affairs. He had also served as the Finance Minister in the united Andhra Pradesh.

Ch. Ayannapratudu has been allocated Panchayat Raj while B. Gopala Krishna Reddy will look after environment and forests. D. Uma Maheswara Rao will be the Irrigation Minister.

Educationist P. Narayana, who was surprisingly inducted into the cabinet despite not being member of either house of the legislature, has been given municipal administration and urban development.

Paritala Sunita will be Minister for price monitoring, food and civil supplies. Palle Raghunath Reddy will take care of information and public relations, information technology and minority welfare.

Sena opposes Maha

The Opposition Shiv Sena has opposed vehemently a move by the State-run Maharashtra Airport Development Company (MADC) to construct an all-weather day-night heliport in the middle of the Mahalaxmi Race Course in south-Central Mumbai.

Apart from raising the issue in the Maharashtra Assembly on Wednesday, the Shiv Sena also submitted detailed memorandum to Maharashtra Chief Minister Prithviraj Chavan opposing the MADC's move to construct an all-weather day-night heliport in the middle of the unused Mahalaxmi Race Course to facilitate VVIP movement in and around south Mumbai.

Raising the issue during a

discussion on budgetary demands in the State Assembly, Sena's group leader Subhash Desai said that the move to construct a heliport right in the middle of the Mahalaxmi racecourse was "totally unacceptable" to his party.

"It has remained an open space and that too a marked open space for more than 100 years now and you want to have a heliport for VIPs and VVIPs here when there are other locations in south Mumbai like Raj Bhavan and Naval helibase at Colaba, where VVIP choppers are being allowed to land and take off," Desai said.

Desai urged the chair's intervention to stop the ongoing efforts by the MADC to seek land transfer formalities from the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation. The chairman of the MADC, the

While he spoke mostly in a reconciliatory tone, Modi did not fail to take a dig at Mallikarjun Kharge, leader of the main Opposition party, Congress, who had invoked Mahabharata to remind the BJP that like Pandavas, the Congress would come back to power.

"As the Mahabharata was mentioned here (Lok Sabha) yesterday, I am reminded of Duryodhana who said he knew dharma and truth but did not have the inclination to follow that.

Likewise, they (Congress) also knew what was the right thing to do, but they did not do it. We will do it," he said amidst thumping of desks by Treasury benches.

After his reply, the motion was adopted unanimously.

The Government's stand in legal proceedings was based on considered facts and decisions and cannot be changed in different courts, sources said.

The Congress demanded General VK Singh's resignation for tweeting allegedly derogatory remarks against Lt General Dalbir Singh Suhag and urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to censure the Minister. The demand for VK Singh's dismissal was raised by Captain Amarinder Singh and Anand Sharma in the Lok Sabha and the Rajya Sabha respectively.

Raising the issue in the Upper House, Sharma said the matter was "very serious" and the comments by a Minister do not "sugar well".

Soon after the matter came to light, VK Singh justified his decision to impose a DV ban on Lt Gen Suhag, tweeting, "If unit kills innocents, does

dacoity, and then (the) head of organisation tries to protect them, should he not be blamed? Criminals should go (scot) free!"

While assuring the Upper House that Suhag is the next Army chief, Jaitley said, "If the main Opposition party attacks him (VK Singh), the Minister may defend himself. Moreover, the matter is sub-judice."

Raising the issue in the Lok Sabha, Amarinder Singh said, "Even after his own Government indicted him (VK Singh), the language used by him in a tweet this morning is highly derogatory. To call a next Chief of Army Staff a criminal and those working under him in the forces as dacoits is not acceptable."

The Congress leader said, "I hope Government will take note of this and he will be dismissed from the Council of Ministers immediately."

Eyewitnesses reportedly told the police that the car was travelling at a very high speed. "It was virtually flying," a police official said. The high-end car that was fitted with highly advanced safety features like front and side airbags for those in the front as well as rear seats and crash sensors could not save its occupants from the impact as it was going at a speed reportedly in excess of 100 kmph. The car belonged to the Bansal brothers who had bought it just six days ago.

The mangled remains of the more-than-₹40-lakh car were moved to Keshav Puram Police Station where police have also registered a case under Section 337/338/279/204A (rash and negligent driving causing death) and investigations are underway.

Most of disabled opt for humanities

New Delhi: With the last date to apply for Delhi University admission drawing near, Equal Opportunity Cell has received more than 180 applications from persons with disabilities students. Members of the Equal Opportunity Cell (EOC) said that the humanities are the most sought after by these students. "Political Science, History and Hindi are the most popular courses among PwD students. However, there are a few takers for Commerce, none for Science," said a counselor at EOC which facilitates admissions for PwD students. "Most of hearing-

impaired students opt for 'Business Commerce' he added. Almost 50 per cent of PwD students that come to DU are visually-impaired, the counselor said. While the figures for the numbers of forms received in admission centres under this category are unknown, more than 180 persons with disability have already submitted the offline optical mark registration (OMR) forms of the EOC office. Over 250 PwD students have made payments online, said an official from the cell. The online and offline forms cost Rs 50 for the PwD. Last year 623 students had applied and were admitted to several DU colleges under this category. SR
